Bharath Beekeeping Centre Information

Bharath Beekeeping Centre is the only institution offering a free one-year course in beekeeping. Since its inception in 2003, many of our graduates have successfully entered the beekeeping industry.

Applicants who apply to our centre often have prior theoretical knowledge from various government-recognized agencies for beekeeping, as well as from new researchers in the field. Our focus is on the protection of honeybees during the rainy season (May to September), during which the training period consists of nine sessions dedicated to artificial feeding.

From September to October, trainees will learn to identify different types of bees, such as the queen, drone, and worker. Additionally, five sessions will be held on colony division, covering techniques such as extracting queen bee larvae, replacing old queen bees, and selecting the best queen larvae to introduce into other colonies.

In November, two sessions will focus on bee colony development through artificial feeding. The following five sessions will teach the technique of lifting bee brood from the bottom to the top of the hive. The final sessions, from February to April, will give a comprehensive overview of honey production from rubber plantations. The course will complete a total of 52 sessions by April.

The entrance for the new batch and certificate distribution for completed courses will take place in April 2025.

Training Process and Benefits

Selected candidates will be divided into groups and provided with individual beekeeping boxes, helping them develop a personal connection to their work. Students will also have the opportunity to purchase bee colonies at a discounted rate.

To support students further, a program has been introduced for the storage of honey from our certificate holders at better prices than those set by the government. Students who attend all classes will receive a beekeeping box and hive equipment at subsidized rates through a partnership with the State HortiCorp of Kerala.

Terms and Conditions

1. Any form of misbehavior towards classmates or the institution will result in immediate dismissal from the course and cancellation of registration without further notice.
2. Practical classes will be held on the second Saturdays or on both Saturdays and Sundays as needed.
3. Students with at least 90% attendance will be eligible to receive a certificate or applicable subsidies.
4. Attendance will be recorded in a register.
5. The last date for submitting the completed application form is March 31, 2025, by 5:00 PM.
6. Please ensure the application form is completed accurately and without errors.
7. The institution reserves the right to modify the rules and regulations of the training program at any time.
8. The completed application form must be accompanied by an online payment of Rs. 1000/- as the registration fee. This payment will be credited to M/s. Bharath Beekeeping Centre, Avanniserry, Thrissur.
9. Registration fees will be refunded to students who successfully complete the course and receive a certificate.

10. The registration fee will not be refunded if the student fails to achieve 90% attendance, is dismissed from the course, or has three consecutive absences.
11. The training is completely free of charge.
12. The theoretical content for each class will be provided in advance.
13. Students must arrange their own food and accommodation for practical sessions. The institution does not provide these facilities. Students must also bring their own notebook and pen.
14. Training sessions will be held from 10:00 AM to 3:30 PM.
15. Students are required to confirm their attendance by phone or WhatsApp at +919495320199 number later than the day before each class
16. Interested individuals may purchase beekeeping tools and bee boxes from the institution at discounted rates.
17. Eight practical sessions will be conducted at Avanisserry, with the remaining four sessions held at various migration locations.
18. Applicants are required to provide four passport-size photographs. One photograph must be affixed to the downloaded application form, which will serve as the admit card for the institution, and the remaining three should be securely attached. Additionally, students must bring a copy of their Aadhaar card. Both the admit card and the Aadhaar card are mandatory for all practical sessions.
19. As honeybees can sting, students are required to wear protective clothing as instructed by the institution.
20. The institution is not responsible for any injuries, including stings or allergic reactions caused by bee stings, that may occur during the training. Students must follow all safety guidelines and wear the protective clothing provided by the institution to minimize risks.
21. If there are more female students who need to do the practical in a separate female group, the institution can arrange a separate batch for them.
22. Please ensure you thoroughly understand the rules and regulations before registering for the course. Once registered, the institution will assume that you have read, understood, and accepted all the rules and regulations. No complaints or arguments regarding the rules will be entertained after registration..
